The Perry County Health Department would like to let citizens with disabilities know that they are entitled, under law, to fair and equal opportunities with respect to their daily lives including accessibility to public areas.

The Illinois Attorney General's *Disability Rights Bureau* enforces the Illinois Environmental Barriers Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act in Illinois and strives to ensure access to buildings and services for people with disabilities by investigating complaints and to resolving violations through mediation and litigation. In addition, the Disability Rights Bureau provides advocacy, information and referral services to people with disabilities.

If you feel that violations of these acts are occurring you may file an Accessibility Complaint Form, which can be acquired from the Internet or directly from the Disability Rights Bureau. Information or complaints regarding: *Parking, Sidewalks, Curb Ramps, Pedestrian Ramps, Entrances Doors And Doorways, Corridors And Aisles, Passenger Elevators, Stairs, Bathrooms, Water Fountains, Public Telephones, Control And Light Switches, Signs And Identification, and Warning Signals And Hazards*, may be obtained or filed with the Bureau.
